There may be times when you need to speak with someone right away. Although we make every effort to be available to you, there may be times when you cannot reach us. Clinic phones are answered after-hours with clinician coverage. If you have an issue that is urgent and need to discuss and a provider is not available immediately please do not wait for the provider to call you back before contacting other resources.

If no provider is available at the time you call and you feel as though you cannot wait for the call back, you will need to call the local crisis center or go to nearest emergency room or dial 911. If it is a medical emergency or you are in danger of harming yourself or someone else, you must call 911 immediately. Do not wait for a response from a provider.
